

PART ONE: THE INNER YOU

In Part One of the interpretations you will read two sections concerned with your individual traits.

The first section describes your ego (sun), emotional make-up (moon), learning and intellectual orientation (Mercury), relationships and sociability (Venus), and the expression and focus of your physical energy (Mars).

The second section describes how well you deal internally with the external situations that you experience in life. Your capacity for happiness (Jupiter), ability to tolerate restrictions and frustrations (Saturn), how you are associated with or relate to new or innovative ideas and methods, and radical ideas and events that upset the status quo (Uranus), how you are associated with or affected by public ideals, morality, and spirituality (Neptune), and how you are associated with or affected by public policies toward crime, toward the power of government and industry, and toward exploration, development, conservation and distribution of natural resources (Pluto).

SUN

The sun rules will power and ego. It is the core of your potential and uniqueness as an individual; who you are and what you are about. It represents the main direction and focus you want your life to take, and your determination to accomplish what you set out to do. It is your personal honesty and integrity, and the ability to command respect and authority, to impress and influence others.

SUN in SCORPIO O in M

As the eighth sign of the zodiac, Scorpio represents the eighth stage in the evolution of man and his place in the universe. This stage is concerned with an emotional development that goes beyond Cancerian concern with home and family. Scorpio's emotional involvement is not based on love or pleasure, but on the control and understanding of human emotions and the role they play in the mysterious process of life and death. Though all Scorpios do not spend their lives pondering the mysteries of life and death, most of them are inquisitive, probing individuals. They are fascinated with how things work, especially people. Their mental and physical powers of recuperation are remarkable, and truly evolved Scorpios can learn to use their power to help and inspire others.

Scorpios are stubborn and impervious to changes not of their own making. However they accomplish many things in life because of their tenacity in sticking with projects when others lose patience and stamina. On the surface they may seem easy-going, congenial, and gregarious but they are also extremely tenacious with a tendency to manipulate and control. Keys to their success are a strong will and the ability to get to the bottom of things. They want answers and doggedly persist until they get them. Astrological symbols for Scorpio are the scorpion and the eagle. They representative the potency and range of the formidable power and control that Scorpios can develop.

Scorpios react emotionally to everything they experience in life. Before they take physical action, before they sort out the practicality of what they are doing, and before they reason things out intellectually, they express their feelings. Though their emotions are the strongest motivational factor in their behavior, unlike the emotionally oriented Cancerians and Pisceans, Scorpios are not apt to wear their hearts on their sleeves. They consciously or subconsciously want to dominate relationships and rarely exhibit emotions openly. Even when they seem to be open, they always hold back something of themselves. They may not intentionally want to be mysterious but many of them manage to appear enigmatic anyway. They do not like being crossed or manipulated, and react to such treatment with sarcasm and vengefulness.

Modern astrologers assign Pluto, planet of intensity and depth, as the ruler of Scorpio. Ancient astrologers (unaware of Pluto's existence) assigned Mars, planet of fire and energy, as the ruler of Scorpio. Both of these planets can be seen to influence the nature of those born in Scorpio. The focus and concentration of their expressions and personality makes them appear magnetic and powerful. The fiery energy of Mars that is exhibited when they are enthusiastic attracts and inspire others. Their intensity can be overwhelming but also subtle. Their considerable energy is not aroused or employed just to have something to do as is often the case with Aries, the other Mars-ruled personality. Unlike Aries, Scorpio is not openly combative unless it becomes necessary. Their privacy is tightly protected, and others get to know them only up to a certain point. They may not show any sign of inner struggle but when they are after something or someone their determination is fierce. Should they not be favored in the outcome, they are not willing or gracious losers. They are not arrogant and, in fact, are quite interested in others and what others have to say. However they often exhibit a self-sufficiency that implies there isn't much they don't already know.

Scorpios have a strong, competitive nature. With little effort they become exceptional athletes. They want real challenges and will not easily suffer would-be competitors who do not possess skills that are equal to their own. They enjoy sports that require strength, swiftness, and cunning. Body-building, soccer, hockey, hunting, swimming, scuba

diving, and spelunking are favorite activities. Scorpio is associated with the mythical phoenix rising from the ashes. This symbol not only represents their own recuperative powers, it also represents their resourceful ability to create something new out of something old or useless. Recycling, and renovating homes and other buildings are typical projects for which they are well suited. Creative potentials include those who are outstanding cooks, writers, designers, and composers. Their shrewdness in assessing value makes them excellent real estate agents and developers, bankers, stockbrokers, and financial planners.

Scorpio colors are red, black, midnight blue, and emerald green. Vulnerable parts of the body are the reproductive organs and excretory system. Headaches, infections, and fevers are Scorpio complaints. Topaz is Scorpio's birthstone. The Roman naturalist, Pliny the Elder, traced the name to the Island of Topazos which, in Greek means "to guess." This meaning is a fair description of the inquisitive, mystery-loving nature of Scorpio. Topaz, one of the hardest minerals, cannot be cut with a knife. It is yet another representation of the impenetrable Scorpio nature. Scorpio flowers include the anemone, heather, and gardenia.

MOON

The moon rules desire as opposed to ego, need as opposed to expediency or reason. It describes how you feel about yourself, how you handle relationships, and how you emotionally respond to situations and experiences. It describes the flow of your daily functions; physical, emotional, and mental. The moon represents your residence and domestic environment. It rules babies and young children, your mother and other important females in your life.

Those born with the moon in a Fire sign want to turn their feelings into physical experiences. They do not initially view their desires from the standpoint of practicality, emotional commitment, or as a lesson to be learned. Before anything else there has to be action, some form of instant physical gratification. As lunar Fire sign personalities, those with moon in Aries go after what they want (or think they want) with passion and energy. They can soon lose interest in relationships with people who don't demonstrate the same passionate enthusiasm. Their adventurous spirit makes it difficult for them to settle down and accept the responsibilities and drudgery of daily routine. On a short-term basis they can become passionately involved with people and projects, but long-term commitments can make them feel trapped. Restless and impatient, they have quick, sometimes volatile, tempers. Fortunately, as quick as they are to get angry, they are just as quick to forget the incident that prompted it.

Aries moon personalities are dedicated to getting their own way, finding one means or another to accomplish their goals. They are meant to be the master of their own success or failure in life. Some of them relish this challenge, while others are all too willing to blame their mistakes on everyone else. Their easily aroused emotions can be dangerously misguided, especially when they act with undue haste, aggressiveness, or anger. Their dynamic self-assertiveness can make them resentful of all authority but their own, and aggressiveness can make it difficult for them to take direction or advice from others. They can become self-indulgent, overconfident and just plain foolhardy, or, they can turn into inspired leaders, and become tireless in their efforts to accomplish things in which they passionately believe. The spirit of their generosity can sometimes be overshadowed by careless disregard for the feelings of others.

Women with Aries moon can often be unflatteringly aggressive in romance and other situations that require a subtle approach. However, they are emotionally well-suited to meet and conquer many challenges that would destroy less hardy types. Men with Aries moon may expect too much and give too little in romance, but they are emotionally equipped with an enterprising spirit, and what is often a uniquely clever and original approach.

MERCURY

Mercury indicates mental outlook, intellectual endeavors, the way you think and communicate. It represents ideas, methods, and information. It rules your hands and thus your manual dexterity and mechanical skills. Mercury also describes transportation; that is, how you get where you're going physically and mentally. Do you speed with all possible haste or amble along taking a few detours here and there?

Individuals with natal Mercury in Libra want to see their ideas translated into money and other tangible rewards. Many of them seek to earn their living in mental rather than physical endeavors. Literary pursuits can range from a fondness for gossip magazines to serious studies in literature and talent for writing. Artistic tendencies include crafts, music, art or design. Interest in the law can turn them into court reporters, courtroom spectators, lawyers, or judges. Their objectivity and unbiased approach works well in impersonal situations but it can hamper situations where more emotional expression and less intellectual analysis are required. Their methods and approach to learning and transportation are rapid and enthusiastic, tending, whenever possible, to embrace the more luxurious forms. Expect then, to find them pursuing literature in an expensive car.

VENUS

Venus rules your social attitudes and behavior, and your aesthetic tastes and inclinations. It is female relationships and social interactions at every level. Venus indicates your values. It describes romance, marriage and other partnerships, capacity for humor, and the pursuit of pleasure.

VENUS in SCORPIO

Social attitudes and behavior of individuals with natal Venus in Scorpio are strongly influenced by their emotional needs. They are not usually shy and, in fact, many of them are quite gregarious. How much attention they seek for themselves is determined by other factors. They have a strong, passionate nature that they must control if they wish to avoid being possessive, obsessive, or jealous. Even those who seem outwardly easy-going will consciously or subconsciously seek to control relationships. They are not ones to mince words or engage in idle flattery. Many of their interactions with others, even fleeting or superficial contacts, are apt to be tinged with a certain intensity. Social instincts can be remarkably keen, and their actions in this regard are direct and purposeful though not always obvious or open.

MARS

Mars rules physical energy and efforts. It describes the strength and direction of the physical force that drives your ego, fires your emotions, and encourages your mental endeavors and communicative skills. It describes male relationships and associations, risk-taking inclinations, and the physical challenges you are likely to encounter.

MARS in LIBRA ♂ in △

The energy of those with Mars in Libra is primarily directed toward ideas and communication. Their efforts can be strong and focused, but the motivational force behind their efforts often relies on interacting with other people. If they have limited opportunity to work in partnership or in cooperative arrangements with others, they find it difficult to get things accomplished or to develop their own potential. The Libran influence implies the possibility of special talent in law, art, design, and music. They are not particularly geared for wasting energy in combative gestures, and will more than likely go out of their way to avoid direct conflict. They are good strategists, able to accomplish things through diplomacy and charm instead of physical force.

JUPITER

Jupiter rules your potential for growth and expansion on many levels; physical, intellectual, spiritual, cultural, and the accumulation of

material assets, power, and status. It describes your optimism and aspirations. It represents your father and his position in society.

JUPITER in LEO

Individuals with natal Jupiter in Leo generate enthusiasm for growth and expansion in many areas, but most often their energetic focus is in art, design, drama, or religion. Whatever direction their efforts take however, it is liable to be somewhat overdone or exaggerated, as is the usual case with Leo's influence. Generosity is to be expected in these individuals, as well as the capacity for maintaining high principles. The pomp and pageantry of traditional rituals attract their imaginations and inspire their enthusiastic participation.

SATURN

Saturn rules responsibilities, restrictions and limitations you are apt to encounter, and the lessons you must learn in life. It does not deny or diminish imagination, inspiration, spirituality, and good fortune but it does demand that these things be given structure and meaning.

SATURN in SCORPIO

Individuals with Saturn in Scorpio encounter responsibility and restriction involving payment of debts of one kind or another. The kind of debts they have are determined by other factors in their natal chart, but they may be of an emotional, physical, financial, or moral nature. The intensity associated with Scorpio and the rigidity of Saturn indicate confrontation with limitations that are imposed by the presence of too much control in some area of their lives, or manipulation in order to gain control.

URANUS

Uranus rules personal as well as societal freedom. It indicates originality of thought and expression. In society it rules radical ideas and people as well as revolutionary events that upset established structures. Uranus takes approximately seven years to transit one sign, taking about 84 years to complete all twelve signs. Since groups of people with Uranus in the same sign are separated by 84 years, the influence of this planet in a sign is generational. The personal implications of Uranus in your life are described by its house position and the aspects it makes with other planets in your natal chart. It describes areas of unpredictability, and where you or your life style may be different than those around you. It relates to the unusual or unique. Friends and associations to which you belong are also indicated, as is your potential involvement with science and technology, computers, and the media.

The generation of individuals born with natal Uranus in Leo are likely to be involved in the creative arts. They introduce their ideas with innovative flair and great boldness in defiance of traditional concepts. Leo is also associated with scientific research and humanitarian gestures, so these individuals may also be expected to attack old problems with new energy, ideas and methods.

NEPTUNE

Neptune rules those who are oppressed or abandoned; the misfits of society. On a higher level it rules visionaries, and those who are glamorous and charismatic. It represents spirituality, mysticism, and ideals. Neptune is in one sign for approximately thirteen years, taking about 164 years to complete its cycle through all twelve signs. Since 164 years separate people born during its transit of one sign and those born when it returns, Neptune's significance in any sign is described as generational or historical. On a personal level, Neptune's house position and the aspects it makes with other planets in your natal chart will describe spirituality, abstract thinking, illusion, disillusionment, and other areas of your life where things aren't always what they seem. It rules derangement, guilt, persecution, and describes the potential for experiences related to confinement, abandonment, and addiction or physical intolerance to drugs.

NEPTUNE in LIBRA

During the most recent period of Neptune in Libra in 1942-1957 the establishment of the United Nations was typical of the Libran effort to establish peace. Neptune's influence is also evident since the U. N. has had minimal effect in accomplishing its goals. Equality (Libra) for minorities (Neptune) may get attention but real solutions may prove illusive.

PLUTO

Pluto takes approximately 248 years to make one cycle through all twelve signs. The period Pluto spends in each sign can vary from twelve years to thirty two years due to the eccentricity of its orbit. Like atomic energy (a force ruled by Pluto), the presence and direction of Pluto's energy are never obvious until it is used. Pluto's influence in any sign is interpreted as generational or historical. In your personal life, Pluto's significance is interpreted from its house position and the aspects it makes to other natal planets in your horoscope. Pluto rules intense energy, and describes the areas in which you consciously or subconsciously seek to exercise power or control. Pluto is also linked to your karmic responsibility, and in this respect, it describes the areas where you must gain the deepest level of understanding.

PLUTO in LEO ♀ in •

Pluto's last period in Leo was 1938-1957. Leo rules the king or representative government. During Pluto's transit of Leo in the late 1600's and early 1700's, John Locke, philosopher of the English Revolution and American Revolution, wrote his famous essays stating that governments existed by virtue of voluntary agreements and their function was to protect the rights of individuals.

PART TWO: THE OUTER YOU

In Part Two you will read about the twelve houses of the horoscope. The houses represent areas of life in which you operate on a daily basis. You will read descriptions of how you handle the circumstances you encounter in each of these areas, according to your nature, personality and other traits as they are outlined in Part One.

HOUSE 1

The first house and the sign that rules the first house, which is also known as the Ascendant or Rising sign, describes your outer personality and physical attributes. To some extent it also describes your health and the type of illnesses you may experience.

CANCER ASCENDANT

A Cancer Ascendant indicates those who are dedicated to satisfying their personal ambitions. However, they can appear so vulnerable that it is difficult for others to determine just how determined or strong they really are. They can be quite circumspect and hesitant to reveal their true goals until they are certain of success. There is potential they will have traumatic partnerships, especially marriage. Many of them prefer to marry late in life, and tend to select older or more mature partners or those who represent an authority figure.

They are emotionally oriented and may attempt to hide this vulnerability behind a facade of forcefulness even though, more often than not, the ploy is unsuccessful. Emotional vulnerability does not deny personal magnetism or ambition. In fact their emotional commitment to something often causes them to work twice as hard as anyone else, becoming quite successful in the bargain. Home is not just where their hearts are, it is usually where they want to physically spend most of their time and attention.

Cancer is ruled by the moon, which implies strong nurturing instincts that are evidenced in their caring, sympathetic personalities. In return, they also seek to be "mothered" and may be guided in life by a strong person (usually female) who fills this role. Their personalities are subject to great changes. Consciously or subconsciously they are highly

influenced by others. They may, for example, adopt the latest fashions or mode of behavior whether or not it is personally flattering, or they may pursue certain activities they feel give them social status rather than being something they may truly enjoy.

They are apt to possess culinary skills, and design or architectural ability. Whether or not they have talent in these areas, they are apt to have great interest in them. Roundness of face, pale, sensitive skin, and baldness or finely textured hair are physical attributes identified with Cancer Ascendant. Their bodies have a strong tendency to retain water. Their emotional orientation is indicative of an addictive nature, which means it is difficult to escape a battle with excess weight or addictive substances. The breasts, stomach, and digestive system are apt to be their most physically vulnerable areas.

URANUS in 1st HOUSE

Uranus in the first house indicates individuals who tend to be argumentative and who enjoy playing devil's advocate. They believe they are different and unique as an individual, or at least they want to give the appearance of being so. It is one reason they love to take the opposing side in discussions. The personality and appearance of these individuals are often somewhat off-beat or out of step with current fashion. Being different does not necessarily extend to a fiery or excitable nature. In fact, they are more likely to possess a calm, quiet, demeanor much of the time. They are capable, however, of such unexpected behavior and reactions, it is difficult to predict with certainty what they will do in any given situation. Though they may require a certain amount of personal independence, marriage is not usually a problem unless their partner becomes too dependent or too possessive. They can get restless if there isn't enough in their immediate environment to stimulate them but whether or not they will seek to change a boring existence, depends on other motivating factors in their personality and background. They are fascinated by strange and unusual things or people. Intrigued by futuristic topics and technologies, they also have great interest in the past. History and politics are usually their favorite subjects.

URANUS square NEPTUNE

Uranus square Neptune only applies to those born during the first half of the 1950's. This generation was born into a world where popular opinion quickly gets out of control, as it did for example, during the McCarthy hearings. However, harsh aspects to Neptune often mean the influences eventually disintegrate or dissolve. As individuals this generation's lifestyle or social attitudes are influenced in varying degrees by this aspect.

HOUSE 2

The second house describes material assets, how you handle monetary income, and the potential ways it may be earned. It also indicates the values and priorities you establish throughout life.

Leo ruling the second house indicates individuals with a need for possessing advantages. These advantages are linked to their egos and are not necessarily always represented by money or material assets. These individuals may, for example, be more interested in gaining power or personal status by having important friends or acquaintances. Their schemes for attaining what they want can be original and creative, as well as grandiose and unrealistic. Their goals are not always self-centered. They can be very altruistic and include charitable or philanthropic endeavors. How well they handle what they gain, or even if they will succeed in getting what they want, is another matter and not determined solely by Leo's influence on the second house. The point is, that they tend to measure their own self worth by material possessions, power or status, or the grandness of what they are able to accomplish.

JUPITER in 2nd HOUSE

Jupiter in the second house indicates those who like to succeed on their own. Whether or not they actually succeed is not indicated solely by Jupiter's position in the second house. These individuals value independence, especially in monetary matters, and, if not discouraged by negative factors in their personality or background, they thrive on the challenge of making their own money. Negative factors can include those who marry for money, and individuals who either acquire money and property through dishonest means, or become victims of those who do. The influence of Jupiter in the second house suggests opportunity to travel or trade in foreign goods and services as a means of livelihood. Other possible sources of income include consulting, publishing, theater, sports, education, or religion. Jupiter in the second house does not always indicate wealth or luck in monetary matters, but it invariably means generosity and the potential for spending money lavishly and wasting other material and non-material resources. They value knowledge even though they may not be scholars. Jupiter also implies they may receive financial help in attaining education and/or may be the ones to aid others in this respect.

JUPITER sextile NEPTUNE

Jupiter sextile Neptune is a generational aspect that provides society with the motivation and opportunities to expand spiritual growth, increase understanding of spiritualism or the occult, or to improve conditions in mental hospitals, prisons, or among minority groups.

Depending on the personalities and backgrounds of individuals born with this aspect, they will be more or less involved with the areas described above, either in their professions or other activities.

JUPITER conjunct PLUTO

Jupiter conjunct Pluto signifies a generation of people with an urge to explore the mysteries of nature and the universe. Their thinking and attitudes are analytical and investigative. Transforming fundamental ideas about human physical, psychological and mental conditions is their societal directive. Depending on the personalities and backgrounds of individuals born with this aspect, they will be more or less involved with the areas described above, either in their professions or other activities.

PLUTO in 2nd HOUSE

Pluto in the second house indicates those with intense desires. These individuals may focus so intently on attaining something that everything and everyone else becomes meaningless. They find it difficult, if not impossible, to give up one thing in order to attain another. Consciously or subconsciously, they tend to equate wealth or status with control or power. However, the real power these individuals can gain comes through their understanding that money and material assets may be attained but never really owned, and. . . that all things, including the amount of time and the physical body they are given at birth, are merely borrowed. Pluto's influence suggests the potential for complete regeneration of assets. It includes the potential for these individuals to experience circumstances that help them develop much deeper values and priorities. Other potentials include those who are more likely to leave an inheritance than to gain one. Pluto also suggests that by choice or circumstances, there may be secrecy associated with their income or assets.

HOUSE 3

The third house describes your mental state, intellectual orientation, self-expression and communication, early education, mechanical dexterity and skills, immediate environment (neighborhood), and siblings. It indicates physical actions, and transportation, especially within your immediate environment. To a certain extent the third house also describes the job or health of your father.

VIRGO on 3rd HOUSE

Virgo ruling the third house indicates those concerned with communication and transportation. They are apt to be writers, teachers, publishers, salespersons, and involved in community projects, transportation or travel. Other mental occupations such as design and engineering are also indicated by Virgo's influence. There is apt to be a lot of visiting and communication with neighbors and siblings. These individuals seem to always know what's going on in their immediate environment. If they have nothing better to occupy their time however, they can be guilty of becoming more involved in idle gossip than in genuine community business. They are apt to have well developed critical and analytical facilities and a high degree of instinctual understanding. Not ESP exactly but what may seem like ESP. The negative potential of Virgo's influence can mean speech impediments, hearing loss, or learning disabilities. It also includes accident proneness, tendency to experience mechanical difficulties, or lack of mechanical ability. The positive side of Virgo's influence indicates talent for arts and crafts, medicine, food preparation, and a lot of common sense.

HOUSE 4

The fourth house describes your residence, domestic environment, and family members, especially your mother. It indicates the beginning as well as the end of various cycles in your life.

LIBRA on 4th HOUSE

Libra ruling the fourth house indicates individuals who probably feel more comfortable, and thus more sociable and romantic, in the comfort of their own homes. They are likely to do most of their entertaining at home, and want their residences to be a place of beauty and harmony. Their work may be in real estate, architecture, or interior design. If they have culinary skills their presentation of food will be a work of art, and they may have particular flair for preparing desserts. There is possibility of inheritance from the mother or mother's side of the family. They are apt to select a marriage or business partner from among those who come from their home towns. A fourth house Libra influence indicates sociable relationships with parents, particularly the mother. It also may mean the mother is beautiful or has artistic talent. The negative potential can mean that by choice or circumstance they do not have a home of their own, they are unable to derive enjoyment from home or domestic life, or that they only use home as a place to camp out when they bother to come home at all. The positive influence is the ability to play the role of peace maker in their families.

SUN in 4th HOUSE

Sun in the fourth house indicates those whose will power and drive are guided by and focused on their home and family. Childhood conditioning has a crucial effect on the development of their ego. Whether their home life exerts a positive or negative influence, they may never be quite free of family relations. Their energy and creativity may be directed to a family-owned business for example. Even the most dedicated world travelers in this group seem to invariably end up back home. The negative potential of this sun house position includes those who dominate

and manipulate their family and domestic environment. The positive potential indicates individuals who rise to prominent positions as a result of help from their family or family connections.

SUN square URANUS

Sun square Uranus indicates those who tend to be highly eccentric, or at least have some eccentricities hidden in what others may view as their fairly straight personalities or demeanors. They may even surprise themselves by their own behavior and reactions to things, which are by no means predictable or consistent from one time to the next. Obstacles they encounter in life are often unexpected and may be unusual.

SUN conjunct NEPTUNE

These individuals are not apt to be overly competitive or ambitious, and when they succeed, it is often a fortunate result of being in the right place at the right time. They are sensitive, intuitive and spiritual. They are also deceptively strong, and masters of disguise. Negative associations with this conjunction include those who are easy victims or victimizers and those prone to hysterics, self-delusion, and addiction. The positive indication are those interested and possibly gifted in art, theater, dance, medicine, counseling, or working with the underprivileged, handicapped or minorities. Water is their natural environment.

MERCURY in 4th HOUSE

Mercury in the fourth house indicates those who prefer to work at home as bookkeepers, writers, researchers, and teachers. They are apt to have a sizable collection of books, magazines, and other written material in their home. If they happen to be more mechanically inclined than intellectually oriented, their home becomes the repository of an array of mechanical devices. Many possess artistic and mechanical skills that enable them to make household repairs and do some impressive interior decorating. Whatever the depth of their intellects, those with Mercury conjunct Mars are sure to be strong and active in promoting their thoughts. They very much want to put ideas into action, and have little patience if they have to deal too much with mere theory. They are often physically active as well as mentally alert, always running here and there on one errand or another. They are likely to possess above average mechanical or technical skills.

VENUS in 4th HOUSE

Venus in the fourth house indicates those who feel more sociable and romantic when in the comfort of their own home, and as a result enjoy entertaining in this environment. They seek to make their home beautiful and harmonious. Books, art, and music play prominent roles in their home decor as well as their activities. They may enjoy presenting musical programs at home or extend the hospitality of their home to literary or art organizations. They may be involved in real estate, architecture, interior or landscape design. Those with culinary skills prepare and present dishes that are as beautiful to look at as they are to eat. These individuals may come from a wealthy or luxurious background. There is potential for inheritance from the mother or mother's side of the family. Venus also suggests they are apt to find a marriage partner in their home town. Negative factors in their personality or background can mean lack of ability to enjoy home or domestic life. These individuals may only use home as a place to camp out, when they bother to come home at all. It can also indicate difficult relationships with parents and other family members.

On the positive side however, they are able to give structure and purpose to artistic endeavors, which is often the key to making such projects important and successful rather than merely frivolous or fanciful.

MARS in 4th HOUSE

Mars in the fourth house indicates those who concentrate much energy and vitality on family and various aspects of home and domestic life. This can have a wide range of potential outcomes. It may indicate that their occupation involves real estate, interior design, architecture, family counseling, or a business operated in their home. Fourth house Mars is a strong indication of an active domestic environment. There may be so much physical activity it is sometimes difficult for them to generate serenity and quietude when the need arises. Their residence is apt to be designed and/or decorated with a distinctly masculine orientation using bold colors (perhaps a lot of red which is a favorite Mars color). There is

SATURN in 4th HOUSE

Being an adopted child is one of the potentials for those with Neptune in the fourth house. Childhood experiences can make these individuals feel they were deprived or abandoned, even if it is not true. They may have a very spiritual, sensitive, or even psychic relationship with their mother. She herself may be deeply spiritual, intuitive or psychic. She may suffer from the use of drugs, or there may be secrets, scandal, or mystery surrounding her or her family. Other potentials include those whose home and family life can be vague or disjointed. Their domestic environment can also be very spiritual, or highly artistic and imaginative. Whatever the home or family is like, there are certain elements of illusion or confusion surrounding it. These individuals may reside near the ocean or other body of water. It is necessary for them to be able to retreat to their home and family in order to restore their mental and physical energies. However, they have to avoid the tendency to hide at home, refusing to face the reality of the outside world. Negative factors include danger of drowning, and those whose home may be damaged by water or gas.

Neptune sextile Pluto is an aspect of extremely long duration. The current sextile between these two planets has been affecting generations for the last forty years. This long term Neptune aspect influences on society represents constant opportunities to change the course of existing structures and pave the way for new ones. Those who will live under the

influence of the other aspects (i. e. , conjunction, square, trine, and opposition) as they occur between these planets in the future will have to deal with the ideologies and other societal institutions that we have had the opportunities to create.

HOUSE 5

The fifth house describes your creative talent and imaginative powers, capacity for enjoyment and the pursuit of pleasure, romance, children, and speculative ventures.

SCORPIO on 5th HOUSE

The subtle energy of Scorpio ruling the fifth house indicates those who want the satisfaction of enjoying outward manifestations of their creative efforts. They may not necessarily want the spotlight for themselves but will seek attention for whatever their creativity has produced. If they lack artistic talent or opportunities to develop such abilities, their creative outlet may be expressed by having children, and their relationships with children are apt to be unusually close. However, there is danger that those who lack a sense of personal security will consciously or subconsciously emotionally manipulate and control their offspring. Capricorn ruling the seventh house has many implications concerning the marital situation of these individuals. One of the first considerations is that they are not apt to meet with good fortune if they marry too young or without a great deal of consideration. There is also the possibility they will marry someone older or more mature. If there are negative factors in their personalities or backgrounds it can mean marriage and its attendant responsibilities may seem so severe as to prohibit their ever attempting to marry. Yet another potentiality is that either they or their marriage partners will view marriage as a means of obtaining security. There is no direct implication of whether they are the ones to embark on such a venture, or the ones destined to be married for their money or status. HOUSE 8

The eighth house is related to taxes, debt, death, legacies, and the income you receive through marriage or business partner(s). It describes your resourcefulness, and your ability to develop and use material assets as well as personal skills and abilities. The eighth house also indicates sexual attitudes and behavior.

Aquarius ruling the eighth house indicates those with unpredictable or unusual attitudes concerning sex that may, in fact, have a tendency to purposely run contrary to current popular opinion. The tenth house describes your career and other long-range goals, public reputation, superiors and those in authority. It also relates to your father and his influence in your life.

also has connection with the job or health of your marriage or business partner.
