

PART ONE: THE INNER YOU

In Part One of the interpretations you will read two sections concerned with your individual traits.

The first section describes your ego (sun), emotional make-up (moon), learning and intellectual orientation (Mercury), relationships and sociability (Venus), and the expression and focus of your physical energy (Mars).

The second section describes how well you deal internally with the external situations that you experience in life. Your capacity for happiness (Jupiter), ability to tolerate restrictions and frustrations (Saturn), how you are associated with or relate to new or innovative ideas and methods, and radical ideas and events that upset the status quo (Uranus), how you are associated with or affected by public ideals, morality, and spirituality (Neptune), and how you are associated with or affected by public policies toward crime, toward the power of government and industry, and toward exploration, development, conservation and distribution of natural resources (Pluto).

SUN

The sun rules will power and ego. It is the core of your potential and uniqueness as an individual; who you are and what you are about. It represents the main direction and focus you want your life to take, and your determination to accomplish what you set out to do. It is your personal honesty and integrity, and the ability to command respect and authority, to impress and influence others.

SUN in ARIES ⊙ in ↑

As the first sign of the zodiac, Aries represents the first stage in the evolution of man and his place in the universe. The raw energy of life itself, which is the first step in being part of the universe, is evident in the character and make-up of Aries people. Babies think of themselves as the center of everyone else's universe. As they grow older, they learn that they are not the center but part of a family group. It is the karmic responsibility of the Aries-born to accept the idea that they are not the center of the universe but part of the larger social order of all men. Aries personalities who do not develop this kind of maturity are demanding and infantile in their behavior. They want what they want, when they want it. The vital life force that is their celestial heritage can either be used to inspire others as well as themselves, or it can be turned inward to reflect only their own selfish needs, and as a result, they fail to evolve as individuals.

Aries people are doers. They set out to accomplish things and are determined to succeed one way or another. The astrological symbol for Aries is the Ram and, considering the sheer force of energy and enthusiasm by which they accomplish their goals, it is not off the mark to suggest that they "ram" their way to success. They must, however, learn the difference between being confidently aggressive—a responsible "take-charge person" on whom others rely to get things moving— and being rudely aggressive—a "know-it-all" who is insensitive to the feelings as well as the wisdom of others.

Aries individuals react in a physical way to everything they experience in life. That is, before they assess the practicality or worth of what they are doing, before they sort out their true emotions, and, before they take time to reason things out intellectually, their tendency is to shoot first and ask questions later. Their passionate nature is inspiring and flattering to others, but unless impatience and rash behavior are curbed, their unbridled enthusiasm backfires when they lose interest just as quickly as they gained it. Theirs is the astrological sign of the soldier but in their haste, they forget the practicality of being adequately armed before rushing headlong into physical or verbal combat. They quickly forget frustration and anger. Since theirs is essentially a generous nature, their selfishness is usually a result of carelessness rather than intentional unkindness.

Active, fiery Mars rules Aries and indeed, Aries people are high-spirited, energetic individuals ready to try anything at least once. Courageous, optimistic, and friendly, they are lively participants in the everyday bustle of life, maintaining a frantic pace others find difficult to match. Constant physical activity works off excess energy, and its vitalizing influence is important to their intellectual and creative endeavors. It is usually the energetic Aries who is willing to start projects others would be afraid to tackle. However, it is also Aries who often fails to finish things when too many details demand attention or they simply lose interest. In spite of the physical energy associated with Aries, they are not above using the inability of others to keep up with them as an excuse for their own idleness. If they expect others to provide them with constant stimulation and are unwilling to find their own diversions, they become lazy. Cut off from physical activity, they become depressed, unproductive, and overweight.

They are eager athletes and generous players. They enjoy the challenge of a tough contest, but they can be so stimulated that they become too aggressive. Aries rules guns and weapons, so it isn't surprising that many Aries individuals enjoy hunting. Combative by nature, they also enjoy boxing, wrestling, and most team sports. They are apt to be mechanically inclined and adept at arts and crafts, typing, working with

machinery, playing musical instruments, or performing magic tricks. They have a tendency to allow their enthusiasm to exceed their actual ability. Before taking something apart, they don't stop to wonder if they can put it back together.

Aries colors are red and white. Vulnerable parts of the body are the head and face. As a sign of this celestial association, many Aries individuals are born with a birth mark on their head or face. Headaches, black eyes, nose bleeds, and insect bites are common Aries complaints. The birthstone for Aries is the diamond. The tremendous heat and pressure that nature exerts in turning carbon into hard, brilliant diamonds represent the strength and physical force in the Aries-born. Flowers for Aries include the poppy (red), geraniums, honeysuckle, and hollyhocks.

MOON

The moon rules desire as opposed to ego, need as opposed to expediency or reason. It describes how you feel about yourself, how you handle relationships, and how you emotionally respond to situations and experiences. It describes the flow of your daily functions; physical, emotional, and mental. The moon represents your residence and domestic environment. It rules babies and young children, your mother and other important females in your life.

MOON in SCORPIO

Those born with the moon in a Water sign need to establish solid emotional commitments. Before considering the practicality of a situation, and before objectively examining the facts, they react emotionally. They are highly intuitive, though at times, it is deceptively self-serving. As lunar Water sign personalities, those with moon in Scorpio are primarily led by their emotions. If they are subjected to emotional manipulation or deprivation in childhood, they are not going to reveal their vulnerability by openly expressing their feelings or needs. If they are raised in a non-threatening environment, they will probably emerge as mild mannered, easy to get along with adults. There is no denying the potential for hedonism, possessiveness, jealousy, and revenge in these individuals but not all of them give in to such destructive energies. Those who do are likely to suffer accordingly, reaping their rewards in this life rather than the next.

Scorpio moon personalities do not want to be rushed or forced into making a commitment. Once they make an emotional commitment to a project, idea, or relationship, they tenaciously pursue and hang on to it. Their emotional nature is accompanied by strong will power and amazing ability to overcome adversity. Instinctive understanding of human motivation and behavior gives them an emotional advantage, a conscious

or subconscious way to control themselves as well as others. The mistake many of them make is being so intent on controlling others, that they never learn to effectively control themselves. Their stubborn nature makes it difficult for others to convince them to change their opinions and behavior or to break undesirable habits.

Women with Scorpio moon are apt to be shrewd, and when they have high intelligence, it is likely to be brilliant. Their ambition is not so much a matter of wanting great wealth for its own sake as it is their desire to gain power. Men with Scorpio moon can be driven to distraction by situations that offer no solution, and by people who refuse to tell them anything. Their emotional nature is well suited to deal with economic, human, or natural resources.

MERCURY

Mercury indicates mental outlook, intellectual endeavors, the way you think and communicate. It represents ideas, methods, and information. It rules your hands and thus your manual dexterity and mechanical skills. Mercury also describes transportation; that is, how you get where you're going physically and mentally. Do you speed with all possible haste or amble along taking a few detours here and there?

MERCURY in PISCES

The mental processes of those with natal Mercury in Pisces are influenced by their emotions. They find it hard to separate emotions from ideas and opinions, frequently allowing passion and idealism to overrule logic. Their mental orientation can be unstable, unrealistic, and overly spiritual. However, they may possess uncanny instincts and remarkable sensitivity to beauty and design. If supported by other strengths, they have a photographic memory, mathematical abilities, and sometimes more common sense than they are given credit for. When it comes to learning and transportation, it is apt to be their emotional strength or weakness that determines whether an individual forges straight ahead or ambles aimlessly from place to place at a snail's pace.

VENUS

Venus rules your social attitudes and behavior, and your aesthetic tastes and inclinations. It is female relationships and social interactions at every level. Venus indicates your values. It describes romance, marriage and other partnerships, capacity for humor, and the pursuit of pleasure.

VENUS in ARIES

Individuals with natal Venus in Aries rush to enthusiastically embrace relationships of all kinds. They enjoy having fun and some of their pursuits may involve an element of risk. Their passionate eagerness can be inspiring and contagious, but a penchant for undue haste sometimes results in being rude. The combative nature of Aries also means they can be too aggressive in forcing their attentions or affections on others. Their social instincts are friendly and, most of the time, attractively uncomplicated. Unwilling to take the necessary time to make proper evaluations, they are not very discriminating in their values and relationships. This is something, however, that can be overcome with maturity and guidance. They are not likely to seek a peaceful or mundane existence, preferring to be active and among people to find their inspiration.

MARS

Mars rules physical energy and efforts. It describes the strength and direction of the physical force that drives your ego, fires your emotions, and encourages your mental endeavors and communicative skills. It describes male relationships and associations, risk-taking inclinations, and the physical challenges you are likely to encounter.

MARS in CAPRICORN

Individuals with Mars in Capricorn are aggressively ambitious. They act more decisively and with greater confidence when they are acting within the limits of what is legally and socially acceptable. They are also more effective when they know they are being observed, and when they know that what they are doing commands respect. Rejection in business or romance is not something they accept easily, and they continue to relentlessly pursue their goals in any way they think will work. The influence of Capricorn may mean a certain ruthlessness in their nature, but that is what it takes to succeed in the fiercely competitive situations they pursue. These individuals are often the ones responsible for bringing about greatly needed changes, and establishing institutions and structures that ultimately benefit many people other than themselves.

JUPITER

Jupiter rules your potential for growth and expansion on many levels; physical, intellectual, spiritual, cultural, and the accumulation of material assets, power, and status. It describes your optimism and aspirations. It represents your father and his position in society.

JUPITER in PISCES

The personal growth and expansion of individuals with natal Jupiter in Pisces is often dependent on their ability to make prudent choices that place them in positions of emotional strength. Emotional sensitivity implies deep spirituality, artistic talent or psychic ability. It can also mean emotional dependency, which in turn, results in reliance on

addictive substances. Their optimism can take a wide variety of forms, from those who exhibit risk-taking behavior that amounts to a death wish to those who possess the instincts and capabilities of a successful commodities trader.

SATURN

Saturn rules responsibilities, restrictions and limitations you are apt to encounter, and the lessons you must learn in life. It does not deny or diminish imagination, inspiration, spirituality, and good fortune but it does demand that these things be given structure and meaning.

SATURN in SAGITTARIUS

Sagittarius is associated with higher education, spirituality, politics, travel and international endeavors. Individuals with natal Saturn in Sagittarius encounter limitations and responsibilities in any of these areas. There is also much to be gained, and they may end up as acknowledged experts and authorities in their particular fields of endeavor. Knowledge is not usually a luxury for them. It may be difficult to acquire purely for its own sake, and it must have structure and meaningful application. Their spirituality demands the highest standards but those who become morally righteous are apt to suffer.

URANUS

Uranus rules personal as well as societal freedom. It indicates originality of thought and expression. In society it rules radical ideas and people as well as revolutionary events that upset established structures. Uranus takes approximately seven years to transit one sign, taking about 84 years to complete all twelve signs. Since groups of people with Uranus in the same sign are separated by 84 years, the influence of this planet in a sign is generational. The personal implications of Uranus in your life are described by its house position and the aspects it makes with other planets in your natal chart. It describes areas of unpredictability, and where you or your life style may be different than those around you. It relates to the unusual or unique. Friends and associations to which you belong are also indicated, as is your potential involvement with science and technology, computers, and the media.

URANUS in SAGITTARIUS

The generation of individuals born with natal Uranus in Sagittarius are concerned with nationalism, internationalism and the basic conflicts these ideologies cause. They explore new concepts of higher education. They develop new technology, and different psychologies that affect publishing, advertising and travel. They initiate revolution within established religious institutions.

NEPTUNE

Neptune rules those who are oppressed or abandoned; the misfits of society. On a higher level it rules visionaries, and those who are glamorous and charismatic. It represents spirituality, mysticism, and ideals. Neptune is in one sign for approximately thirteen years, taking about 164 years to complete its cycle through all twelve signs. Since 164 years separate people born during its transit of one sign and those born when it returns, Neptune's significance in any sign is described as generational or historical. On a personal level, Neptune's house position and the aspects it makes with other planets in your natal chart will describe spirituality, abstract thinking, illusion, disillusionment, and other areas of your life where things aren't always what they seem. It rules derangement, guilt, persecution, and describes the potential for experiences related to confinement, abandonment, and addiction or physical intolerance to drugs.

NEPTUNE in CAPRICORN

Neptune's last period in Capricorn was 1820-1834 and its current transit is 1984 -1998. Capricorn rules conservatism and Neptune brings extremist tendencies. The 1800's witnessed the "era of Metternich, " the powerful, very conservative Austrian statesman. Conservative tendencies in France were accentuated when Charles X gained the throne. In Great Britain the conservative Tory faction maintained control. The conservative mood in America under Ronald Reagan and continuing under George Bush is evidence of the present influence of Neptune in Capricorn.

PLUTO

Pluto takes approximately 248 years to make one cycle through all twelve signs. The period Pluto spends in each sign can vary from twelve years to thirty two years due to the eccentricity of its orbit. Like atomic energy (a force ruled by Pluto), the presence and direction of Pluto's energy are never obvious until it is used. Pluto's influence in any sign is interpreted as generational or historical. In your personal life, Pluto's significance is interpreted from its house position and the aspects it makes to other natal planets in your horoscope. Pluto rules intense energy, and describes the areas in which you consciously or subconsciously seek to exercise power or control. Pluto is also linked to your karmic responsibility, and in this respect, it describes the areas where you must gain the deepest level of understanding.

PLUTO in SCORPIO

Pluto's current transit in Scorpio is 1984-1995. When Pluto transits Scorpio emotional transformations occur that produce conflict, and ultimately, great change. The Great Awakening during Pluto's Scorpio

transit in the 1700's increased church participants, but the overall effect divided the church between those of the old order and new members who wanted change. Scorpio rules kidnapping, sex, and abuse. Public outcry against child abuse and kidnapping and the world-wide spread of AIDS are examples of Pluto's current transformation of society.

PART TWO: THE OUTER YOU

In Part Two you will read about the twelve houses of the horoscope. The houses represent areas of life in which you operate on a daily basis. You will read descriptions of how you handle the circumstances you encounter in each of these areas, according to your nature, personality and other traits as they are outlined in Part One.

HOUSE 1

The first house and the sign that rules the first house, which is also known as the Ascendant or Rising sign, describes your outer personality and physical attributes. To some extent it also describes your health and the type of illnesses you may experience.

An Aries Ascendant indicates individuals with success-oriented personalities. They like to be the ones in charge and want to make definite impressions everywhere they go. They are dedicated to satisfying personal ambitions and can sometimes pursue their own ends with selfish disregard for the feelings of others. It doesn't necessarily mean they are always selfish but in their haste and enthusiasm to reach some goal or accomplish some purpose, it is easy for them to forget that others may be involved, or that what they are doing may have an adverse effect on others. A strong need for accomplishment, combined with the characteristic Aries courage they possess, urges them to go after things others might think are too dangerous, too foolish, or too much work.

Aries implies energy and enthusiasm. Once motivated, they seldom hesitate to act. Their enthusiasm can get out of hand and they tend to overestimate their own abilities or the influence they have. For the most part they maintain an informal approach to life, with easy, open mannerisms and an attitude of "take me as I am". They confront situations openly and with force, but may not necessarily be openly aggressive and, in fact, many are quiet, hard-working individuals who sublimate their energy inconspicuously in one or a variety of low-key activities. Those afflicted with the restlessness often characterized by Aries, can find it difficult (though not impossible) to develop a lengthy concentration span, neatness, or a high degree of organization.

Aries is ruled by the fiery red planet Mars, and as a celestial reminder

of this association, many of them have reddish hair, ruddy complexions, or a distinctive birthmark on their heads or faces. Working for themselves makes life easier for their sometimes headstrong personalities, but they don't mind being one of the rank and file as long as they don't find the work objectionable and are treated fairly by supervisors. Though they can be easy-going about many things, attempts to force authority on them are likely to provoke strong resistance. Though often rash, their passions are sincere.

They are apt to have mechanical abilities or cleverness in one form or another. High fevers, eye strain, skin rashes, overwork, migraine headaches, and insect bites are their most likely physical complaints.

SUN in 1st HOUSE

Sun in the first house indicates those who consciously or subconsciously seek to dominate their immediate environment. Whether or not they actually do is another matter, since their personality is developed and guided by their ego. If the ego's ambition is not strong, then the personality is not likely to be assertive. No matter what the rest of the world may think of them, it is meaningless compared to what they think of themselves. Pride can make it difficult to accept advice or criticism. Though much of their enthusiasm and efforts are directed inward to the greater glory of the self, they are generous and loyal to their friends. Their energy and vitality can be very inspiring to those around them.

SUN square MARS

Sun square Mars indicates those who tend to be confrontational and aggressive. Unnecessary competitiveness and impatience are often the reasons for their personal disasters. Their egos are too easily affronted and this can be their undoing. However, turning the energy of frustrations into constructive action is what gives many of them the necessary drive to accomplish the things that in the end make them highly successful.

SUN trine SATURN

Sun trine Saturn indicates individuals with a certain type of luck. There is no lucky throw of the dice they can count on, it is usually luck they make for themselves. They may not win at horse races, but they will always come out ahead in situations where they have worked hard and for which they have prepared well. Their own actions or other people impressed with their past prudence and hard work provide any additional help they need to get ahead.

SUN square NEPTUNE

Sun square Neptune indicates those who may often be at a loss to explain how and why their problems occur. Just when they think things are resolved, it turns out there are facts they didn't know, or loose ends still to be taken care of. Getting to the bottom of things and taking care of details is possible but often difficult. The best way for them to succeed is to handle the here and now, stick to the facts and what they actually know, and let everything else take care of itself.

VENUS in 1st HOUSE

Venus in the first house suggests those with much personal charm and, in most cases, physical attractiveness as well. Though some of them may at times be avant garde as a social statement of sorts, they rarely go to extremes in either their looks or personality. Their features, especially facial features, are evenly balanced. Even if they are not beautiful, their charming personality and mannerisms enhance their physical appearance. They enjoy dressing well, and use cosmetics and other beauty aids with desirable results. The negative potential associated with Venus includes those who may be rude or anti-social. It can also mean either those with total disregard for anything other than their appearance, or those with a completely uncaring attitude about how they look or behave.

VENUS trine URANUS

Part of the reason those with Venus trine Uranus are apt to succeed in life is because of their amiable personal approach in meeting people, an approach that makes strangers feel they have known these individuals all their lives. They are egalitarian and do not fear crossing or defying social barriers. There are no hidden meanings in their actions or conversation and no complicated strings attached to their social relationships.

HOUSE 2

The second house describes material assets, how you handle monetary income, and the potential ways it may be earned. It also indicates the values and priorities you establish throughout life.

TAURUS on 2nd HOUSE

Taurus ruling the second house indicates individuals who may be addicted to the personal pleasures and material advantages that wealth can supply. To attain these things, they take full advantage of all the charm and physical attractiveness they possess. To them, it may seem an even trade. It also implies that beauty provides their income in such fields as modeling, hairdressing and related services, cosmetic manufacturers and salesmen, fashion and beauty consulting. Other possible sources of income include law, art, music, jewelry or the world of fashion and design. Though their second house Taurus influence suggests they place great value on wealth and beauty, it indicates they probably

also value their relationships. Their sense of well-being and security is greatly enhanced when they are surrounded with beautiful things, attractive, peaceful environments, and people they like. Negative potentials for Taurus on the second house include individuals who are unable to derive personal enjoyment from anything or anyone. Their self-denial can lead to miserliness, selfishness, or a waste of resources.

HOUSE 3

The third house describes your mental state, intellectual orientation, self-expression and communication, early education, mechanical dexterity and skills, immediate environment (neighborhood), and siblings. It indicates physical actions, and transportation, especially within your immediate environment. To a certain extent the third house also describes the job or health of your father.

GEMINI on 3rd HOUSE

Gemini ruling the third house indicates individuals who are concerned with communication, languages, or transportation. Responding to the Gemini influence many of them are writers, teachers, publishers, salespersons, or those heavily involved in community projects and associations, or who work in the transportation or travel business. Other mental occupations, such as design and engineering are also indicated as possibilities. There is apt to be a lot of visiting and communication with siblings. The negative possibilities include speech impediments, hearing loss, or learning disabilities. It also implies accident proneness, tendency to experience mechanical difficulties, or lack of facility with mechanical devices. They always know what's going on, especially in their immediate environments. In some individuals with nothing better to occupy their time, there is more involvement in idle gossip than in genuine community business. The influence of Gemini on the third house means they are likely to possess a high degree of instinctual understanding. Not ESP exactly but what may seem like ESP.

HOUSE 4

The fourth house describes your residence, domestic environment, and family members, especially your mother. It indicates the beginning as well as the end of various cycles in your life.

CANCER on 4th HOUSE

Cancer ruling the fourth house indicates powerful ties to home and family. If these individuals are deprived of these elements in childhood, they find some way of fantasizing them. Sometimes their desire to idealize their family causes them to fantasize even when they experienced, what could be considered by most standards, a normal childhood. Though this Cancerian position indicates strong emotional identification with home

and family, it does not mean the home life is emotionally stable. In fact, frequent changes of residence are more than a possibility. They may reside near or on the water, or at least may have great desire to do so. They usually prefer to work at home. Their mothers are apt to play pivotal roles in their lives. Either they gain strength or special assistance from her, or are profoundly affected by her death or absence. Loss of the mother however, is not necessarily a negative factor, but may turn out to be a positive force in pushing them forward. They may have responsibility for the care of their mothers or bear great physical resemblance to her.

HOUSE 5

The fifth house describes your creative talent and imaginative powers, capacity for enjoyment and the pursuit of pleasure, romance, children, and speculative ventures.

CANCER on 5th HOUSE

Cancer ruling the fifth house indicates strong emotional identification with animals and children. It implies sensitive, romantic individuals who may be quite fertile, either literally or figuratively or both. They may have a tendency to be lax disciplinarians when it comes to dealing with children or pets, but they more than make up for it with their affectionate concern and patience. There is nothing to suggest with certainty they will possess creative talent, but they are sure to have great fondness for the arts or entertainment industries. Unless other factors in their backgrounds interfere, they attract a multitude of friends and acquaintances. They may experience difficulty in gaining emotional maturity in some areas, and are apt to have appetites that are hard to control. There is danger that they will waste their talents if they do not develop a high level of self discipline. Though it doesn't mean they don't enjoy traveling or getting out of the house for social activities, for the most part, they are likely to derive their greatest enjoyment from doing things at home or with family members.

HOUSE 6

The sixth house describes your job, daily responsibilities (paid and unpaid), and those who work for or with you. It also represents your health, and physical fitness.

Leo ruling the sixth house indicates individuals whose egos are expressed in their work. Whatever occupies them on a daily basis; their job or duties, people they work with, and those for whom they are responsible, whether family or employees or even pets, are matters of great (possibly overblown) concern to them. They take personal pride in

routine affairs. If there is no opportunity to take obvious pride in this area they may either fail to make progress, or become guilty of overplaying or fantasizing what is in reality dull and routine. Many conduct themselves, no matter what they do, with such dedication, pride and preciseness in handling even the most routine business, that they inspire the open admiration of others who are less organized or motivated. They are apt to become the most competent and also the most flamboyant employees. They may work long and hard but they do have limits, and sooner or later will demand tangible recognition for their efforts. Health and fitness may be important issues.

HOUSE 7

The seventh house relates to marriage and partnership or joint ventures of any kind. It describes how you interact with people and how others tend to regard you. The seventh house is associated with legal matters, negotiations, contracts, and all open confrontations, pleasant as well as adversarial.

LIBRA on 7th HOUSE

Libra ruling the seventh house indicates those who are apt to be outgoing, people-oriented individuals. They dislike doing things alone. Without constant exposure to others, they can become withdrawn and unmotivated because they depend on interactions for inspiration and feedback. They may have exceptional skills of strategy and debate, and are apt to encounter more than their share of open confrontations in life. They derive much pleasure and enjoyment from marriage, though they may have trouble in this respect until they learn not to equate romance and charming manners with emotional commitment. The negative potential of this Libra influence can mean difficulty finding the right partners, or antisocial attitudes either on their part or that they engender in others. They are apt to have courtly public manners and are unfailingly polite to everyone they meet. But, for all their sociability on a one-to-one basis, they hate waiting in line and being in crowds. HOUSE 11

The eleventh house rules friendships, organizations to which you belong, and income derived from self-employment or career (as opposed to wages earned from a job). It relates to the role you play in the lives of others as child, parent, lover, spouse, friend, social or business associate. The eleventh house also describes your hopes and aspirations and capacity for happiness.

CAPRICORN on 11th HOUSE

Capricorn ruling the eleventh house indicates the likelihood of heavy responsibilities associated with friends. Capricorn does not imply lack of friends but they are apt to be few in number. These individuals will also tend to establish more friendships later in life, or with people older than themselves. There is also implication that friendships will be solid, enduring relationships.
